County lady came for the well approval.

It appears that the well must be 50 ft from septic, and septic 100 ft from lake. She was concerned about the age and style of the septic. Expressed concern about failure. I stressed that usage was minimal - only 2 baths here, and seasonal - so she let it go. (over)

But, she put the new well in front of the house. Probably better, because the well head can't be vulnerable to being hit by a car. It would be if placed in rear. However, the feeder line must cross the sink drain. I couldn't tell her about that. -

Thursday June 2 -

Steve Baer got here at 9:00 am to drill the new well. New well all in by 5:30 - water pressure is fantastic - the utility room is clean and Steve Baer is a great guy!!

The hot and clear days meant lots of time in and around the lake for swimming and to give the babies time to meet their daily quota of sand/rock eating. As far as yard work, I spent a bit of time on my Sisyphus-esque task of hauling eroded sand back onto the beach. I rebuilt a rock border near where the dock is set up to make the yard/ beach border more distinguishable.

RE: COLIFORM IN THE WELL WATER

24/7 I performed another independent test for coliform and definitely confirmed the initial test results. While it may sound alarming, the truth is that coliform in groundwater wells is extremely common like Bruce mentioned in his email with the fact sheet. I'd bet that it was also present in the old well - we just didn't have it tested so we didn't know.

Our options are to do a chlorine bleach disinfection/ flush to kill current contamination and re-test to see if that did the trick. If not, we have other treatment options available for ongoing disinfection if necessary.

In the mean time, here are the water options:

1. Boil water (rolling boil) for 3 minutes to kill coliform.
2. Buy bottled - we've left some gallons of Glacier from Family Fare in Bellaire which can be refilled there for 39 cents each.
3. Drink the water anyway - I drank it with no ill-effects. We all showered, washed dishes, rinsed off, etc. and did not experience problems.

For younger children, it's advised to drink bottled water to be on the safe side.

We'll get the water problem solved, everyone. If all else fails, we can survive by drinking the pure, unfiltered lake water which we have a bountiful amount of available. ☺ Kidding!
